

# ROMANHARPER

Roman played for the Alabama Crimson Tide football team. He was a four-year letterman, a three-year starter and finished his college football career as one of the best Safeties to ever play at Alabama. As a sophomore, he totaled 114 tackles, second most on the team that season. As a junior, he was a second team All-Southeastern Conference selection. As a senior, he was a first team All-Southeastern Conference selection.

Roman was drafted in the second round by the New Orleans Saints in 2006. He became a starter that season to round out one of the best Secondaries ever assembled in the NFL. In 2009 and 2010 Roman earned his two Pro Bowl berths. In Super Bowl XLIV, Roman led the Saints with 8 tackles and defeated the Indianapolis Colts 31-17.

In 2014, Roman was signed by the Carolina Panthers. During that season he won numerous awards including NFC defensive player of the week. In week 17 against division rival Atlanta Falcons, Roman recorded 6 tackles, 1 pass defended and a 31-yard pick six.

In 2016, Roman was a key leader for the best Secondary in the NFL knows as "Thieves Ave." The Panthers fnished the season with a team record 15 wins and The Thieves lead the NFL with 24 interceptions and six fumble recoveries. As the NFC Champions, Roman and The Thieves played in Super Bowl 50. In 2016 - 2017 Roman returned to the Saints, where he played a leadership role on the defense by mentoring and coaching the Saints' younger Safeties.
